Breweries	Beers	Tasting Notes
Bank Top	Gold Digger 4.0%	Golden coloured with a citrus aroma. Grapefruit and a touch of spiciness on the plate leading to a fresh, hoppy citrus finish.
	Volunteer 4.2%	A great Anglo American alliance - pale bitter brewed with an English malt and American hops leading to a full floral after taste.
	Port O Call 5.0%	Roast barley flavour with Port overtones - definitely not mild!
Copper Dragon	Golden Pippin 3.9%	A light refreshing blonde ale brewed using a specially selected hop to create a citrus fruit flavour. This golden coloured favourite is equally appealing to real ale and lager drinkers alike.
	Challenger IPA 4.4%	A truly traditional premium ale brewed to revive flavours enjoyed by our victorian ancestors. Full bodied and fruity with subtle hoppy undertones.
George Wright	Drunken Duck 3.9%	A light citrus ale combining 3 hops from the Americas. Perfect for the hop lover. Colour: Light Straw.
	Pure Blonde 4.6%	Aroma is bursting with floral hop with noteable lemon and orange characters. Taste is similarly hoppy, dry bitter full of flavour.
	Blue Moon 4.9%	A Strong and hoppy ale which does not have a "heavy" taste. Clean and crisp. Colour: Pale Gold.
Hornbeam	Lemon Blossom	A delicious light ale with an aroma of crisp citrus lemon. Perfectly balanced sweetness with delicate bitterness to finish. An exceptional pale ale that leaves you wanting another.
	Top Hop 4.2%	This superb palatable ale is full bodied, with malt appeal and ample bitterness. An excellent bright, premium bitter.
Howard Town	Wren's Nest 4.2%	A light hoppy beer, made with Halcyon and Crystal malts, and Pioneer and Cascade hops.
	Dark Peak 6.4%	Excellent strong Porter with the clever addition of Jamaican Rum make this an unmissable beer.
Millstone	Vale Mill 3.9%	Light gold in colour, hoppy, light and full of citric flavours.
	Tiger Rut 4.0%	A pale and hoppy ale with distinctive citrus arôme.
	True Grit 5.0%	A very pale and hoppy strong ale. Well hopped using only Chinook hop; the mellow bitters make way for a distinctive citrus/grapefruit aroma.
Pennine	Floral Dance 3.6%	A light beer with a taste of lemon sherbet.

Pictish	Brewers Gold 3.8%	A refreshing thirst quenching pale golden session beer. Malty undertones and a powerful spicy hop aroma combine to produce a dangerously moreish beer.

Thornbridge	Wild Swan 3.5%	White gold in colour with aromas of light bitter lemon with spices.
	Jaipur IPA 5.9%	Soft and smooth, building around the mouth to a crescendo of massive hoppiness accentuated by honey.
